



COUNSELLING GUIDELINES FOR BTECH ADMISSION FOR CHILDREN **OF INDIAN WORKERS IN GULF COUNTRIES**

1. Counselling for B.Tech Admission for Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries is scheduled at 9.00 am on **18/07/2017 (Tuesday)** at Seminar Complex, Near Administrative Office, CUSAT, South Kalamassery, Kochi – 682022.
2. Candidate should bring a print out of the online application confirmation page.
3. All candidates who have applied under the category of Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries should report on 18/07/2017 between 9.00 am and 10.00 am and register for counselling. **After 10.00 am, no candidate will be allowed to enter the counselling hall.**
4. The candidates who fail to report within the stipulated time will not be considered for admission to B.Tech under the category of Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries.
5. Before appearing for counselling, the candidate should ensure whether he/she possesses the eligibility criteria. Please read the Prospectus and Notification No. IRAA4/345/Admissions/2017 dated 30/06/2017 carefully for eligibility related information.
6. Based on CAT-2017 rank of the candidates who reported for counselling, allotment will be made on the same day. Allotted candidates must join on the same day by remitting full fees. For fee details please see **Annexure – 1**. Payment can be made online via net banking, credit/debit card/ SB Challan (for cash payment) etc. on the same day. Internet facility will be provided at the counselling venue.
7. Availability of seats is shown in Annexure - II
8. The vacancies remaining, if any, after considering candidates having CAT – 2017 rank will be filled from the remaining applicants who have reported for counselling.

9. At the time of counselling, the candidates should bring the following **original** certificates.

- a) **Certificate / Mark list of Plus Two Examinations and 10th Certificate.**
- b) **Employment Certificate of the parent which is duly attested by Indian Embassy / Govt. Agency.**

OR

Copy of Work Permit, Account Statement of Bank in Gulf Country and copy of VISA which are duly attested by Indian Embassy / Govt. Agency.

- c) **Copy of the Birth Certificate of the candidate or any other Government certificate/document proving the relationship between the candidate and the parent**
- d) **Migration Certificate (if studied from an institution outside Kerala)**
- e) **Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate.**
