Interested candidates, with valid CAT 2018 rank for B Tech admission are directed to report for **Counselling/Admission** on 13/08/2018 at 9.30 am at office of the **Kunjali Marikar School of Marine Engineering, CUSAT, Kalamassery, Kochi – 22** for spot admission to the vacant **B Tech Marine Engineering** seats detailed as below.

Candidates should report at 9.30 a.m. in the above venue. Candidates coming after 10.30 a.m. will not be permitted to register for Counselling/Admission.

A. Certificates / Documents required at the time of Counselling / Admission

I. The applicants shall invariably submit the following documents (Original with a self-attested copy) at the time of counseling/admission to the University:

1. Admit Card of CAT 2018 or the copy of the Application Confirmation Page

2. S.S.L.C / 10th Standard Certificate & Mark List
3. Plus -2 (+2)/ 12th Standard/Pre-Degree/Higher Secondary Certificate & Mark List
4. Degree Certificate & Mark List (*Candidates who have not received the Mark list/ Certificate shall submit a “Declaration” at the time of Counselling/Admission*)
5. Post Graduate Degree Certificate & Mark List
6. Transfer Certificate from the Last Institution/Department attended
7. Conduct Certificate from the Last Institution/Department attended
8. Medical Inspection report from a Medical Practitioner approved by the DG Shipping.

(Note : Candidates without Medical Certificate will be considered only in the absence of candidates with Medical Certificate)

B. Non-resident Indian Seats (NRI)

- i. NRI status is not compulsory but, at the time of admission candidates who select NRI seats should submit the ‘Declaration’ given in Annexure II.
- ii. For NRI seats candidates should have applied for the same at the time of application registration. Others cannot get admission under NRI seats. However, they can participate in spot admission if seats are available.

Note: If a candidate fails to submit the required certificates at the time of admission then his claim for admission to the programme under the category claimed by him will be forfeited. The sole responsibility for such incidents will rest with the candidate only.
