**SPOT ADMISSION FOR PART-TIME B.TECH PROGRAMME**

Final round spot admission to the vacant seats of the Part-time B.Tech. programme (Civil, Chemical, and Mechanical Engineering) of Cochin University of Science and Technology will be held on 12.10.2017 at the IRAA Office of Administrative Building. Interested candidates in the rank list need to register their names between 10 a.m. to 10.30 am. Candidates who have not written the admission test, having 3 year Diploma in the concerned subjects, can also participate. Those who have written the admission test on 19.08.2017 will get preference. In the absence of SC/ST candidates in the first round, seats will be converted to OEC seats in the second round on the same day and OEC candidates available in the rank list can get admitted based on their rank order. In the absence of OEC candidates in the rank list, the OEC candidates who have written the admission test will also be considered for admission. For details contact Ph. 0484-2577100, 2577159

**Eligibility: (1)** Pass in Diploma Examination in Engineering/Technology conducted by the State Board of Technical Education, Kerala or other states or any other equivalent examination after undergoing an institutional course of minimum 3 years duration with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade. In the case of candidates belonging to OBC/SC/ST/OEC categories, the relaxation in minimum marks required shall be as per the norms followed by the University for other B.Tech. programmes. Candidates can seek admission only to the branch of Engineering /Technology in which they possess diploma as detailed below:

- B.Tech in Chemical Engineering** : Diploma in Chemical Engineering/ Chemical Technology/ Petrochemical Technology/Polymer Technology/ Pulp & Paper Technology or equivalent.
- B.Tech in Civil Engineering**: Diploma in Civil Engineering or equivalent
- B.Tech in Mechanical Engineering**: Diploma in Mechanical Engineering/ Automobile Engineering/Production Engineering or equivalent.

**(2)** Candidates should be on permanent technical professional employment for at least two years at the time of application after passing the Diploma Examination in any of the following type of establishments

- Government Organizations.
- Quasi-Government Organizations.
- Industrial firm duly registered under the Company Act.
- Government/Quasi-Government/Private aided/Private unaided Polytechnics and Engineering Colleges in the State.

The course is conducted at School of Engineering, Thrikkakara Campus and the duration of the course is 7 semesters. Admitted candidates should remit the full fee applicable to the programme at the time of admission itself. In the case of SC/ST candidate the fees is not reimbursed by the Government, the candidate has to remit full fees before the first semester examination.

The candidate should bring the following at the time of counseling/admission

- Admit card
- Original of SSLC/10<sup>TH</sup> certificate
- Originals of Diploma Certificate and Mark Lists
- No objection certificate from the Head of the Institution
- Originals of Experience Certificates
- TC and CC of the last attended Institution
- Original of the Community and Non-cremylayer certificate as applicable
- Two sets photocopies of the above documents
- Required semester fee (Rs.43085/-for general candidate and SC/STfor Rs.1460/-)
